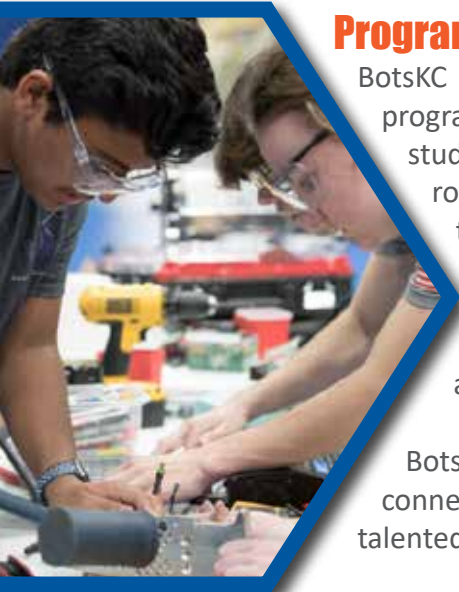

Program Overview

BotsKC is a manufacturing workforce development program supported by regional manufacturers. BotsKC students design and build 15-pound remote controlled robots to face-off in a gladiator-style competition. Through the manufacturing process of bot building, students' imaginations are captured as they design, build and compete with their own robotic creations. Working on hands-on projects in conjunction with industry partners, gives students practical knowledge in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) - essential manufacturing skills.

BotsKC is also an avenue for manufacturers to build valuable industry-school connections. Helping BotsKC teams engineer lean, mean, fighting machines builds a talented workforce pipeline for employers. In other words, everybody wins.

What sets BotsKC apart?

- BotsKC is the only job-driven, project-based STEM learning experience. Created by industry, BotsKC targets manufacturers' biggest issue – recruiting a future workforce.
- Designing, building and testing a bot is a fascinating real-world professional manufacturing experience.
- Students learn the technical and critical thinking skills needed for the manufacturing jobs of tomorrow.
- As industry advisors, local manufacturing companies form partnerships with participating schools.
- BotsKC is Everyone's Sport; all participants have the potential for a career in manufacturing.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

- There is a skills and interest gap in manufacturing. Companies cannot find qualified workers to fill their open positions. This problem is compounded by a rapidly aging workforce.
- 77% of the manufacturing workforce will be at retirement age by the year 2030.
- 2 million positions in manufacturing will be open within the next 10 years.
- 90% of parents recognize that a strong manufacturing base is critical to the US economy, but only 30% of parents would support their child's pursuit of a career in manufacturing.
- BotsKC attracts smart, capable students who love to build things and solve problems.

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

BotsKC provides a structure for educational robotics competitions. Competitions increasing awareness and interest in manufacturing-related career opportunities. BotsKC provides manufacturing companies with students to fill the talent pipelines. BotsKC offers schools a fair, safe and cost effective environment for designing, building and battling robots.

Student teams compete regionally each spring. Teams not only earn points for their arena battles, they are evaluated by industry experts on their engineering binder. The team's documentation binder and presentation points weigh heavily in the crowning of the BotsKC Grand Champion.

While the students get excited about competition, they are also developing technical skills in mechanical and electrical engineering, machining and welding along with 21st century skills in critical thinking, project management, communication and teamwork.

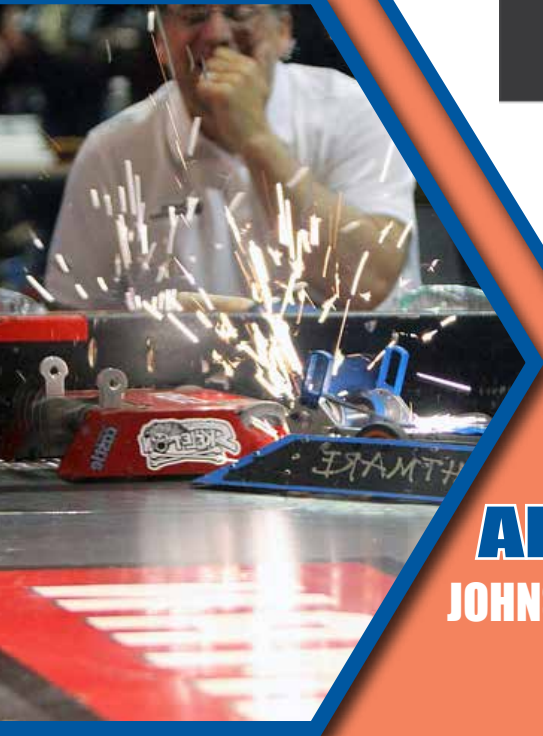
