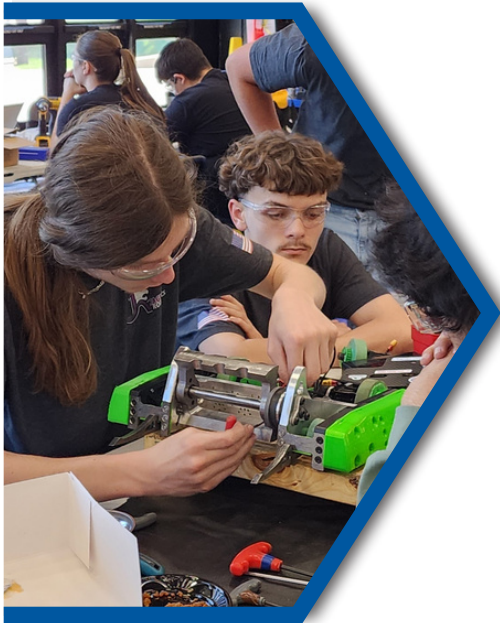

BotsKC BEFORE YOU GO CHECKLIST

In the excitement of getting ready for the BotsKC Competition, it can be easy to overlook important details. We want your experience to be as trouble-free and enjoyable as possible. So, before you go, take time to be sure that all of the following have been taken care of.

- The team registration form has been completed online.
- A parent/guardian has signed the BotsKC Competitor Agreement Form for each student. You can email the form to info@BotsKC.org, or students will not be allowed to participate without a signed waiver.
- Team information paragraph and photos have been submitted.
- Documentation is complete and ready to turn in before the deadline (usually 2-3 weeks prior to competition). Teams must submit a documentation binder to compete.
- All team members have reviewed the BotsKC Competition Rules.
- All team members have reviewed the BotsKC Technical Regulations.
- Room reservations (if required) are complete.
- Be sure to bring the following items with you:
 - Safety glasses for everyone who will be in the pit area
 - Extension cord and multi-plug or power strip for your pit table
 - Wood block for working on your bot in the pit
 - Personal tools
- Safety Inspections will be held by appointment, so plan to arrive early to make your assigned time.
- The BotsKC Competition begins Friday at 10AM with the opening round beginning around 4:30PM. This first round should end around 6PM. The competition will then resume on Saturday morning at 9 AM. If the bots passed inspection, you must leave the bot there overnight - bots can't be taken home after passing inspections.
